COMPARATIVE



SHORT ADJECTIVES



adj + ER + THAN

smart - smarter (than)

small - smaller (than)

adj [e] + R + THAN

large - larger (than)

adj vowel + consonant x 2 + ER + THAN

adj consonant + y: y => I + ER

happy - happier (than)

easy - easier (than)

big - bigger (than)

fat - fatter (than)



LONG ADJECTIVES



MORE + adj + THAN

intelligent - **more** intelligent (than)
dangerous - **more** dangerous (than)

IRREGULAR ADJECTIVES



good - better (than)

bad - worse (than)

much/many - more (than)

little - less (than)

old - older / elder (than)
